Spring! Finally! Or, as it is often referred to here in Texas, "The Pollening!".

There are so many events that mark the end of winter and the beginning of Spring here at church. Most notably, of course, is Easter! I am looking forward to the precious time we spend together each year as we commemorate His Triumphal Entry on Palm Sunday. The sight of all the children entering the Sanctuary with palm fronds is sure to bring a smile to your face. 

Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." -- Luke 23:34
