A Message from the Pastor

I wish I had written this newsletter article yesterday morning. If I had written this yesterday morning, I could have started by sharing my excitement about our upcoming VBS, the growth in our church, the depth of our worship and the joy of our fellowship. Instead, today, I have start with great sadness.

Yesterday afternoon, May 24, 2022, 19 children and two adults were murdered at an elementary school in Uvalde. Texas.

And I really don't have words...

Sadness

Sorrow

Pain

Anxiety

Anger

Fear

Empty

All of those words fall very short of what I am feeling right now. I don't even know how to pray.

And that's Ok...

Now in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know what to pray for as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words; Romans 8:26

Yes, I am looking forward to a successful VBS in June. There are 109 precious souls registered to attend. I want every single one of these children to know that they are loved, they have value, they have purpose and that they are safe! I want us to help them develop a relationship with the Savior who will never leave them nor forsake them. I want them to learn about the Good Shepherd who will both provide for them and protect them.

Today, I appreciate a little more our responsibility to these kids and to our community. The church uniquely has the answer for the cancer of sin in our nation. There is only one thing that can change the hearts of evil men and the heart of a nation; The Gospel of Jesus Christ. It is our privilege and our responsibility to share the Good News!

Hug your kids.


Regular Office Hours



June Lamplight — Acclamation

Just wanted to share...

The scripture passage that I read this morning is applicable in many ways...

Psalm 89:15-16: Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, LORD. They rejoice in your name all day long; they celebrate your righteousness.

This year I have challenged myself to brush up on Hebrew and Greek. Today's word comes from verse 15.

In Hebrew, the word "acclaim" is תְּרוּשָה. It is pronounced, teh.ru.a(h), and has several meanings... anywhere from "a battle cry" to "shouts of praise."

There are different views about the meaning of this word. The context indicates that blessings come to those who have learned to publicly praise God and walk in His light. Another translation leans toward blessings for those who have learned or know the trumpet sound (battle cry) of God.

There is hope in either translation:

- 1. The promise of blessing for those who publicly praise God for salvation.
- 2. The promise of blessing for those who have learned that salvation belongs to the Lord.

Both sound good to me. I was also reminded about the prayer of Habakkuk...

"LORD, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, LORD. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy." ~ Habakkuk 3:2

As you go through this day, remember to praise the Lord for your salvation.

Remember this... you are loved, and you are always in my prayers.
