- Create and execute a long-term, church aligned vision for First Baptist Church of Seabrook's youth ministry.
- Seek to integrate youth ministry into all phases of church life to create a culture that is intentionally intergenerational, striving to unite with and complement other church ministries.
- Promote an environment where youth feel connected to each other as a church family
- Provide biblical counseling and spiritual direction to youth on an individual basis as needed
- Create fun and meaningful opportunities for all youth to connect and grow together.
- Ensure safe and healthy classroom/small group environments
- Maintain contact with students and parents, keeping them informed of ongoing activities.
- Keep parents updated on ministry strategies and plans in a way that encourages partnership and involvement.
- Explore and implement outreach events to connect students and families in the local community to our church community.
- Foster cross collaboration between ministries and area churches.
- Develop a full year calendar that will accomplish our mission and vision as a ministry as well as complement our mission and vision as a church.
- Carefully plan and manage the youth ministry budgets.
- Other duties as assigned by the lead pastor.
